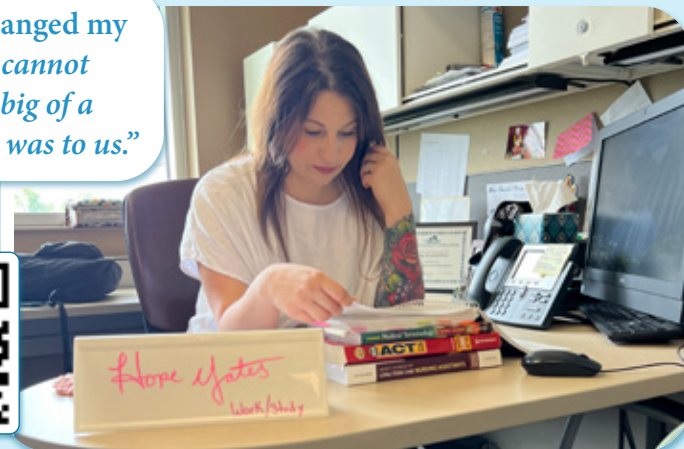

The relationship with the father of my children was very toxic and unhealthy for both myself and my children and I knew it was going to be up to me to provide a happy and healthy life for my little family.

A friend of mine lived at Family Scholar House and she did so well that I always had FSH in the back of my mind when thinking about my future. From the very beginning, I had so much support from the staff. They helped us move into our new apartment, and provided Christmas for my children. Any obstacle I have had to face since being here, I haven't faced alone.

My family advocate and academic coach have supported me through hard times and pushed me to be my best as I work towards graduation. My career coach connected me with many opportunities to network with professionals in the community. FSH workshops have contributed to my confidence and helped me become a better mother and person.

MyKY.info

In July of this year, we announced that the LouieConnect.com web-based app (and kiosks) would roll out statewide as MyKY.info! It is now possible for Kentuckians across the Commonwealth to find free resources at their fingertips.

MyKY.info is a mobile-optimized website that pulls together the services in communities across the Commonwealth of Kentucky to provide support for people seeking a needed resource or experiencing a difficult time. It is free to use, includes only those services that are free, and provides all the information needed to know what they offer, where they are located, when they are open, and any requirements to receive help.

The feedback so far has been overwhelmingly positive and we look forward to adding more services and kiosks in the coming months.
